Brian Kotarsky launched restoration graphics supplier Phoenix Graphix (www.phoenixgraphix.com) more than 20 years ago, as the result of his quest to find high-quality, affordable graphics for his '78 Trans Am. That car, a black Special Edition model has gone under the restoration knife at Wings Auto Art (www.wingsautoart.com).

"Trans Am graphics cost \$1,250 wholesale in 1985," Kotarsky says. "I knew there had to be other options."

Since then, Kotarsky's company has sold what he estimates is "tens of thousands" of Trans Am graphics, as well as graphics for countless other cars. His Trans Am, which he's owned



for nearly 24 years, will see a total nut-and-bolt resto, promising to be one of best restored '78s when the color sanding finally ends. Restorations are never inexpensive, but we're pretty certain that Kotarsky will get a good deal on the graphics.
